



WELCOME TO THE NEW MMDL - THE 21ST CENTURY DART LEAGUE

The **Minute Man Dart League** has been making several major improvements to modernize league operations and become more efficient, user-friendly and take advantage of modern technologies. Please read this sheet carefully as it explains many new procedures of great importance to league members.



ELECTRONIC TEAM ROSTER - For convenience, the Acrobat .PDF version of our team roster is designed to be filled out right on your computer with your keyboard. Click on the fields with your mouse to fill out your information, switch to the next field by pressing the "tab" key. You may then save the document to your computer (**please use "save as" and add your team name to the file name**). You can then print the form out to bring to the captain's meeting. We strongly encourage use of this method to avoid unclear handwriting. Download the form from the MMDL website: www.MMDL.org



EMAIL ANNOUNCEMENTS LIST - All MMDL communications (weekly standings, new season announcements, playoff details, etc.) are no longer sent via postal mail. **ALL** league members, and especially captains, are strongly encouraged to subscribe to the league email address to stay informed of MMDL news. If you do not have an email account, you are advised to ask a friend or relative to assist you. It is the captain's responsibility to keep team members up to date and share league communications with those who do not receive them directly. The league will now be entering all team rosters and match reports into a central database. This will enable us to use our new stats website to provide:

- online weekly standings
- win/loss statistics for teams *and* individual players
- searchable database of league sponsors including links to driving directions

MEMBER REGISTRATION REQUIRED

In order to access the MMDL statistics website, you will need to register an account. To do so, please follow these instructions:

- Go to the stats website at the address above
- On the bottom left side, click "Create an account"
- Enter all information, click "submit" and you're done!
- Once the season is underway and your team information has been entered, you will be able to view your team, your schedule, your team's place in the standings and your individual player stats.

While modernizing league operations has numerous benefits for the league and its members, in order for us to be successful, ***YOUR COOPERATION IS REQUIRED***. If captains do not comply with what is outlined below, unwanted errors may result in your teams' scores, standings and player stats.

LEGIBILITY - PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY WHEN FILLING OUT ROSTERS AND MATCH REPORTS!

The following guidelines regarding your roster and the weekly match report have become more important than ever. MMDL is trying to better enforce these regulations on issues that previously would "fall through the cracks". The league will be lenient this season as a grace period for people to become adjusted to the new system. After the grace period, failure to comply may result in point deductions. ***Please make an effort to make the following part of your standard procedure.***

INDIVIDUAL PLAYERS MAY ONLY APPEAR ON ONE TEAM'S ROSTER PER SEASON

All teams and players are tracked in a computer database, therefore, no players may appear on the roster of more than one team.

PLAYERS NAMES SUBMITTED ON TEAM ROSTERS MUST MATCH NAMES SUBMITTED ON WEEKLY MATCH REPORTS

No Nicknames! If a nickname is used instead of the official player name submitted on the roster, that player will not be recognized as a part of your team and no points will be awarded for games played by that person.

Roster changes must be made official by being approved through your Area Director and registered through the league statistician who enters match reports. No player may be eligible to play for a team without clearing this process. If a name appears on a match report that is not the name of an official member of your roster, no points will be awarded for that player's games.

NOTE: Make sure players with the same name are somehow differentiated (example: Jr. vs. Sr.). The name must appear the same way on both the roster you hand in to the league and weekly match reports.

PLAYERS MAY NOT PLAY MORE THAN ONE OF EACH GAME TYPE (601, Cricket, 301)

If a player is found to have played more than the allowed number of games (1 601, 1 Cricket and 1 Singles), points earned by that player will be forfeit.

MATCH REPORTS MUST BE FILLED OUT LEGIBLY

MORE important than EVER! The league statistician ***MUST*** be able to quickly read your match report so it can be processed efficiently. ALL information (especially player names) must be printed in a way that someone unfamiliar with the person will be able to quickly decipher. ***Reports that are hard to read will delay the entire process and prevent on time publishing of league standings.***
