

PDC Presents the

WORLD SERIES OF DARTS QUALIFIERS



1. Participants must be US citizens and 21 years of age or older. Proof of US citizenship must be presented by the persons who qualify within 7 days of qualifying. Proof consists of a notarized US birth certificate, US Passport, or US Naturalization Certificate.
2. There are no boundaries for the qualifiers. Players may participate in a maximum of three qualifiers plus the Friday Night Midnight Madness.
3. The PDC Dress Code will be in effect for all qualifiers. There will be strict dress restrictions for all players and any player who does not conform to what is required will first be asked to change and then eliminated should they refuse to do so. No Males will be allowed to play in a qualifier should they not be wearing long trousers, sleeved and collared shirts and their attire must not bear any offensive caricatures or words. Any form of shorts are unacceptable. All females similarly must wear nothing which may be deemed offensive, and similarly may not wear shorts of any kind.
4. Smoking and Drinking is NOT permitted during any matches players at any qualifier.
5. Format is best of seven legs of 501, knockout bracket. One toss of a coin will determine who throws first in legs one, three and five and should the game be tied at 3 legs each, then the players shall throw for the bull to decide who will throw first in the seventh and deciding leg.
6. The highest 4 ranked players present according to the BEN Pro Rankings will be seeded into the bracket at each qualifier.
7. Entry fee to the qualifiers is free.
8. Prize money

9. Venues – will need to be able to accommodate 20 free standing dart boards (or have boards in place). Branding for the event sponsor will be required. Dartboards will be provided by Unicorn, and shipped direct to the venue, where possible these should be used in more than one qualifier.
10. Qualifiers should take place on a Saturday or Sunday afternoon/evening.

11. The local qualifier coordinator may obtain local sponsorships other than any beverage company to support there qualifier, raise funds for bringing spectators to the main event in May, or to assist their qualified player in his or her travel expenses to the main event. All sponsors must be approved by the PDC through Bull's-Eye Marketing, Inc. All funds raised by the local coordinators are retained by the local coordinators, however, any such sponsors have absolutely no rights whatsoever in regard to the event at the Mohegan Sun.

12. There is no additional reward for hitting a perfect 9-dart game either in the qualifiers or the main event.

13. All 12 qualified players must register for the World Series of Darts at the Mohegan Sun Hotel and Casinos at the Friday Night Midnight Madness prior to 9:00 PM to verify they are participating. Any of the previously 12 qualified players not registering prior to 9:00 PM Friday night , May 19, 2006, will be disqualified from the World Series of Darts and a replacement player will be qualified through the Friday Night Midnight Madness. All disqualified players will forfeit any prize money or expected compensation.

14. Friday Night Madness May 19th, 2006 at the Mohegan Sun

Staged between 7pm and 10pm, on 16 freestanders, players can turn up, pay an entry fee of \$50, and throw. Players may pre-register for the Friday Night Midnight Madness for \$40 on-line at www.bullseyenews.com prior to 8:00 PM EST, Monday, May 15, 2006. (Players who pay on-line, must bring positive proof of US citizenship or they will not be allowed to compete. There will be no refunds.) Competition is based on the lowest number of darts required to score down from 501, straight start, double finish. The entrance fee includes admission to both days of the TV main event in the closed circuit lounge. (Players must be US citizens and 21 years of age. All players participating in the Friday Night Midnight Madness event must bring positive proof of their US citizenship: US birth certificate, US Passport or US Naturalization Certificate. Players not having original positive proof of US citizenship that evening will not be permitted to compete. No exceptions.)

After 10pm the top 16 players, plus all ties, will go into a straight knockout bracket, no seeds, and will play best of 7 legs. From this bracket, four players will go through to the fill the final 4 positions of the main event.

Entry is open to any player who is a US citizens and 21 years of age or older, including those that may have played in a qualifier, and has proof of US citizenship as described above.
